M.V.O.A. POLICY OFFICIALS TRANSFERRING INTO MANITOBA

Prior to becoming an active member within the Manitoba Volleyball Officials

Association, a transferring official from another province or territory must provide the following documentation:

- a) A letter from their previous R.O.C. indicating:
- Their current level of certification
- If they are in good standing within their previous province or territory.
- b) A list of their activity within the past year (verified by the transferring province). Should the above documentation be termed incomplete, insufficient or questionable, then the R.O.C. / M.V.O.A. executive will base the officiating level of the transferring referee on several critiques done by certified M.V.O.A. evaluators. The cost of these critiques will be equal to the honorarium the transferring referee is to receive.

M.V.O.A. Membership:

Regardless, this transferring official will not be eligible for upgrading until he/she has officiated in Manitoba for a full year and has completed at least twenty (20) matches.

Should the transferring referee be enrolled in a Volleyball Canada upgrading program, be it national or international, said referee may continue in program with future expenses to be negotiated between the referee and the M.V.O.A.
